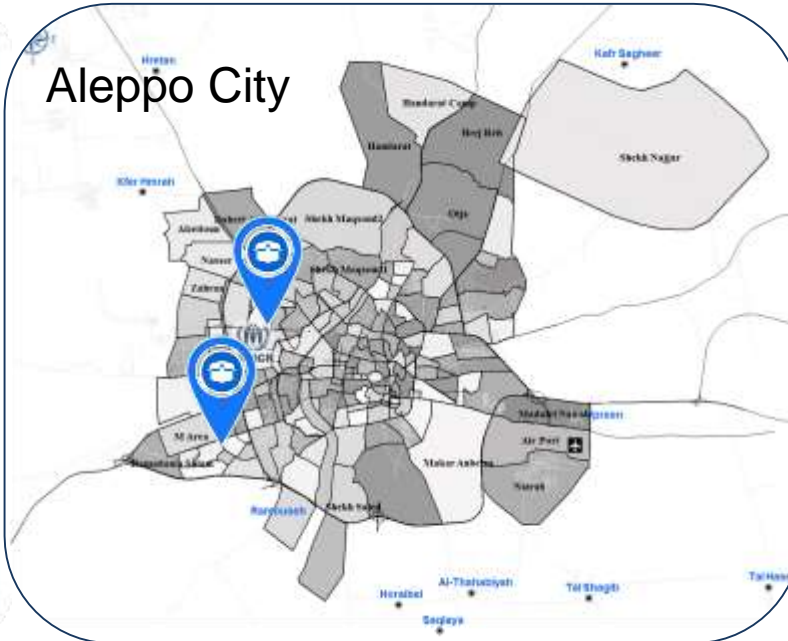
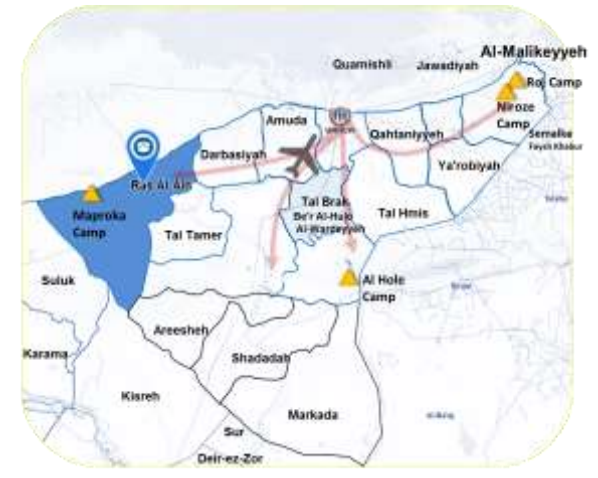
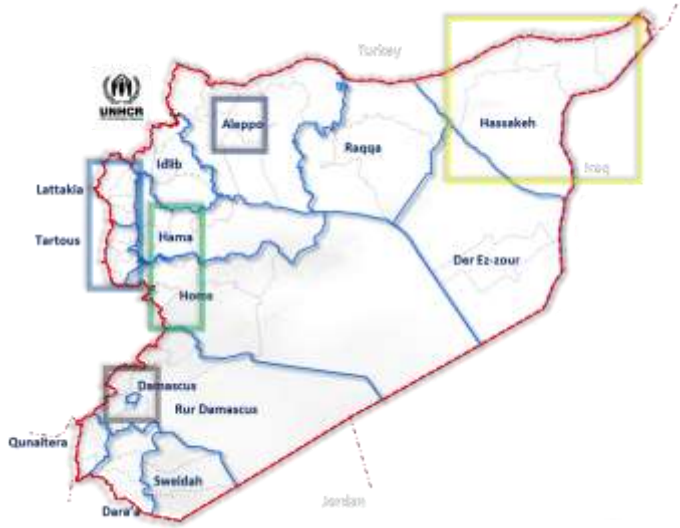


Distribution Methodology :

Supplementary Items: (Targeting Those Most in Need) Solar Lamps, Sleeping Bags, Winter Jackets , Thermal Underwear	

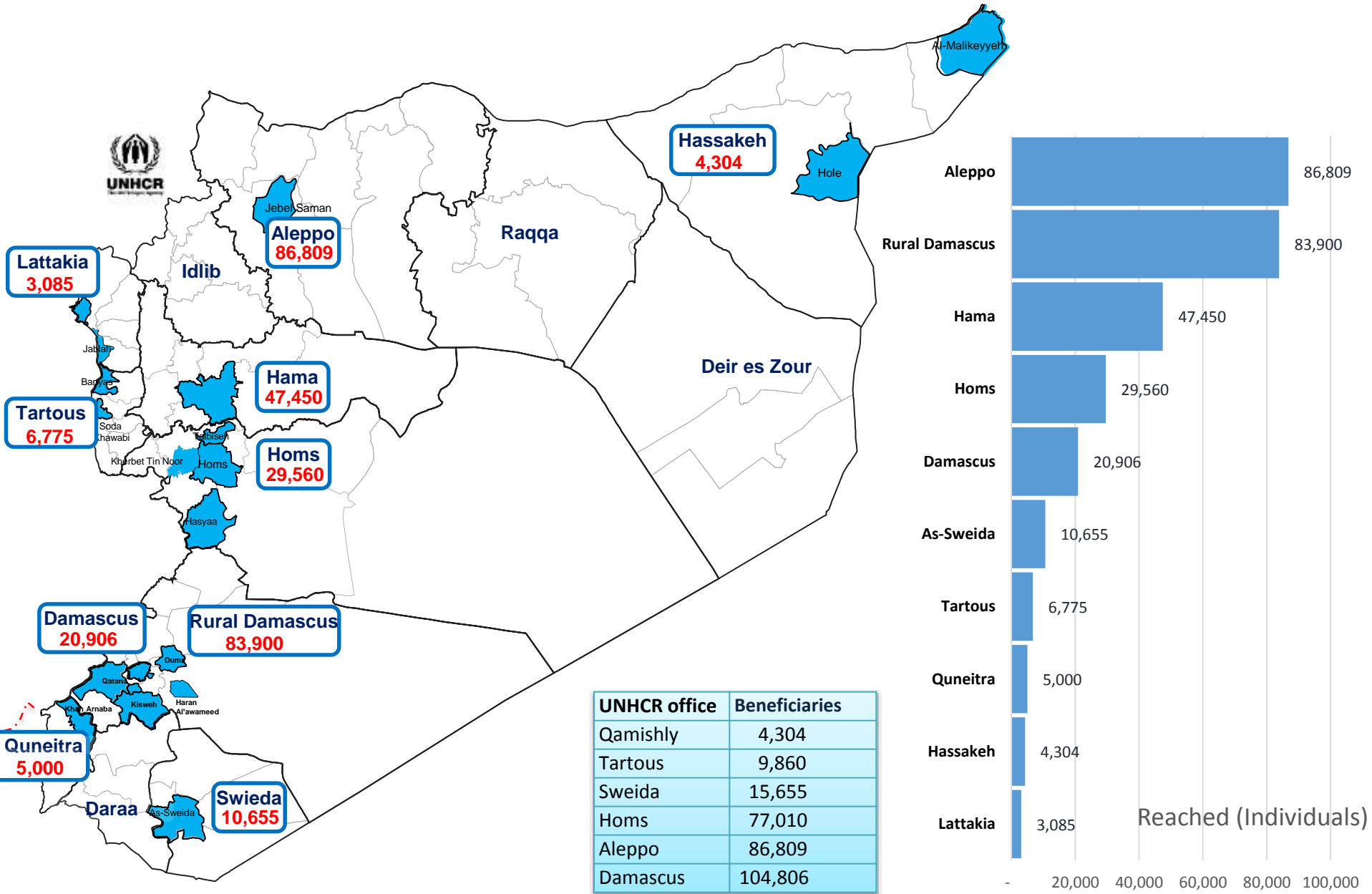

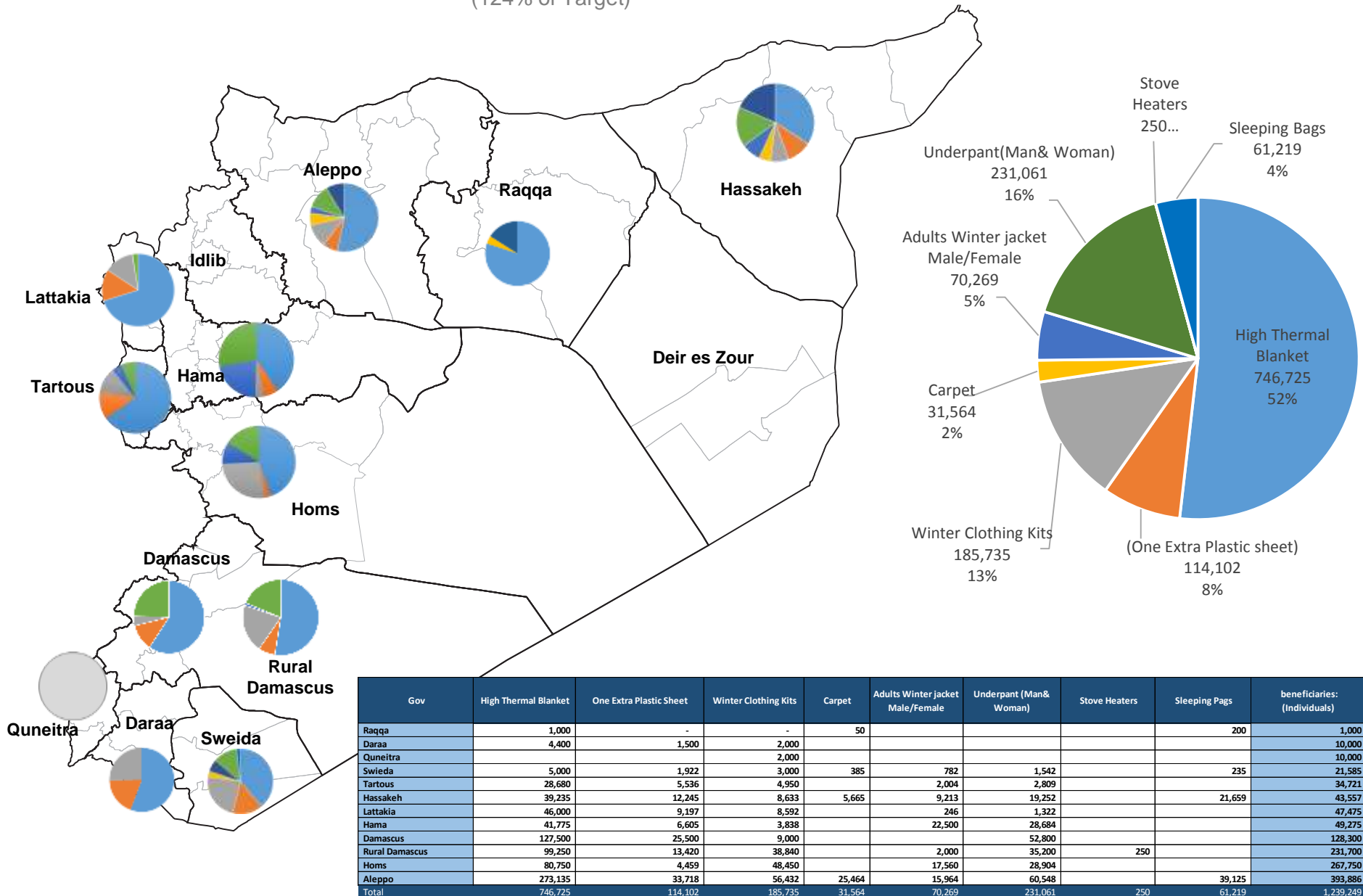

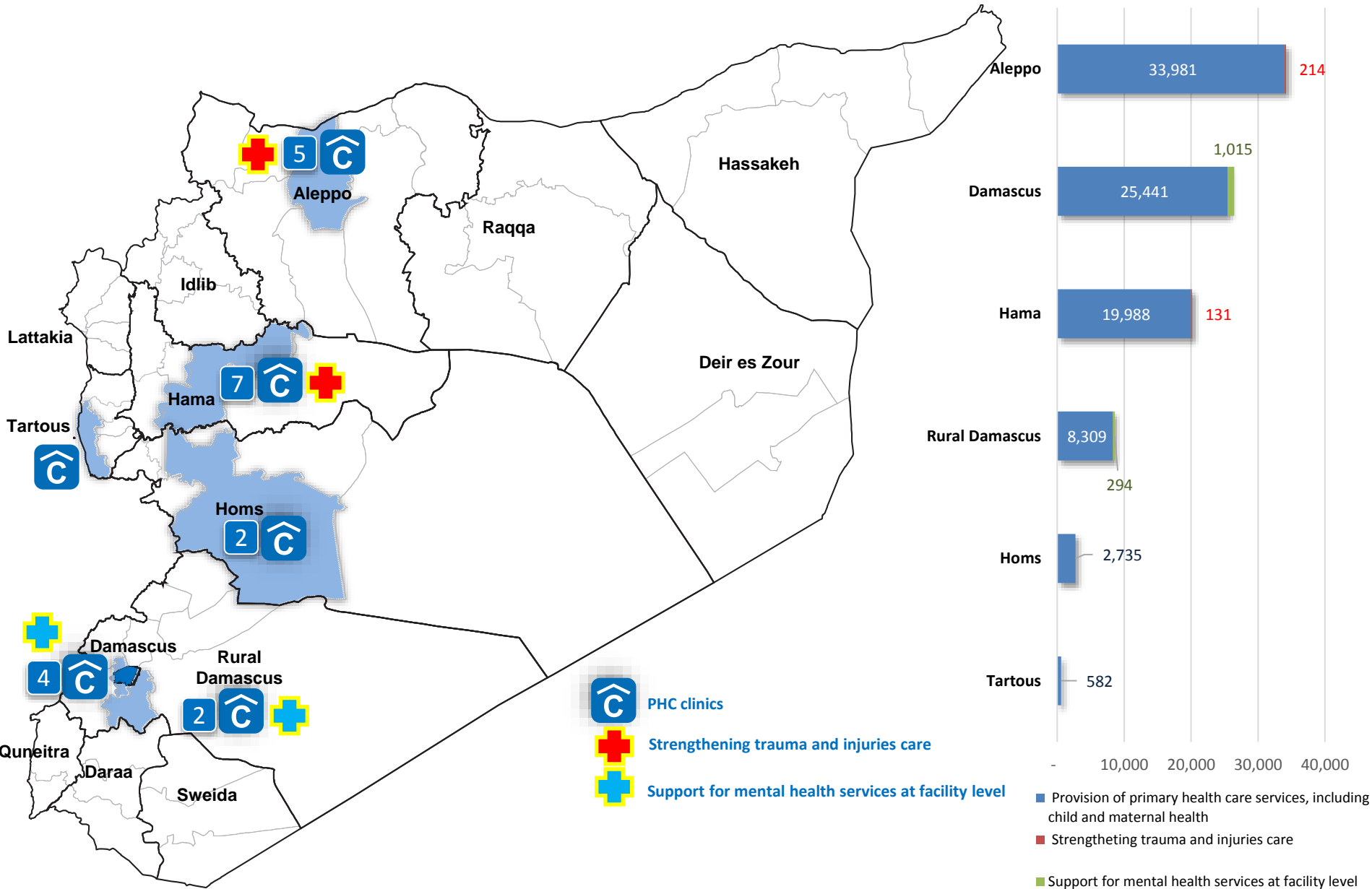


Winterization Programme 2016/2017 Concluded on 28 February with **1,239,249** Beneficiaries Assisted
