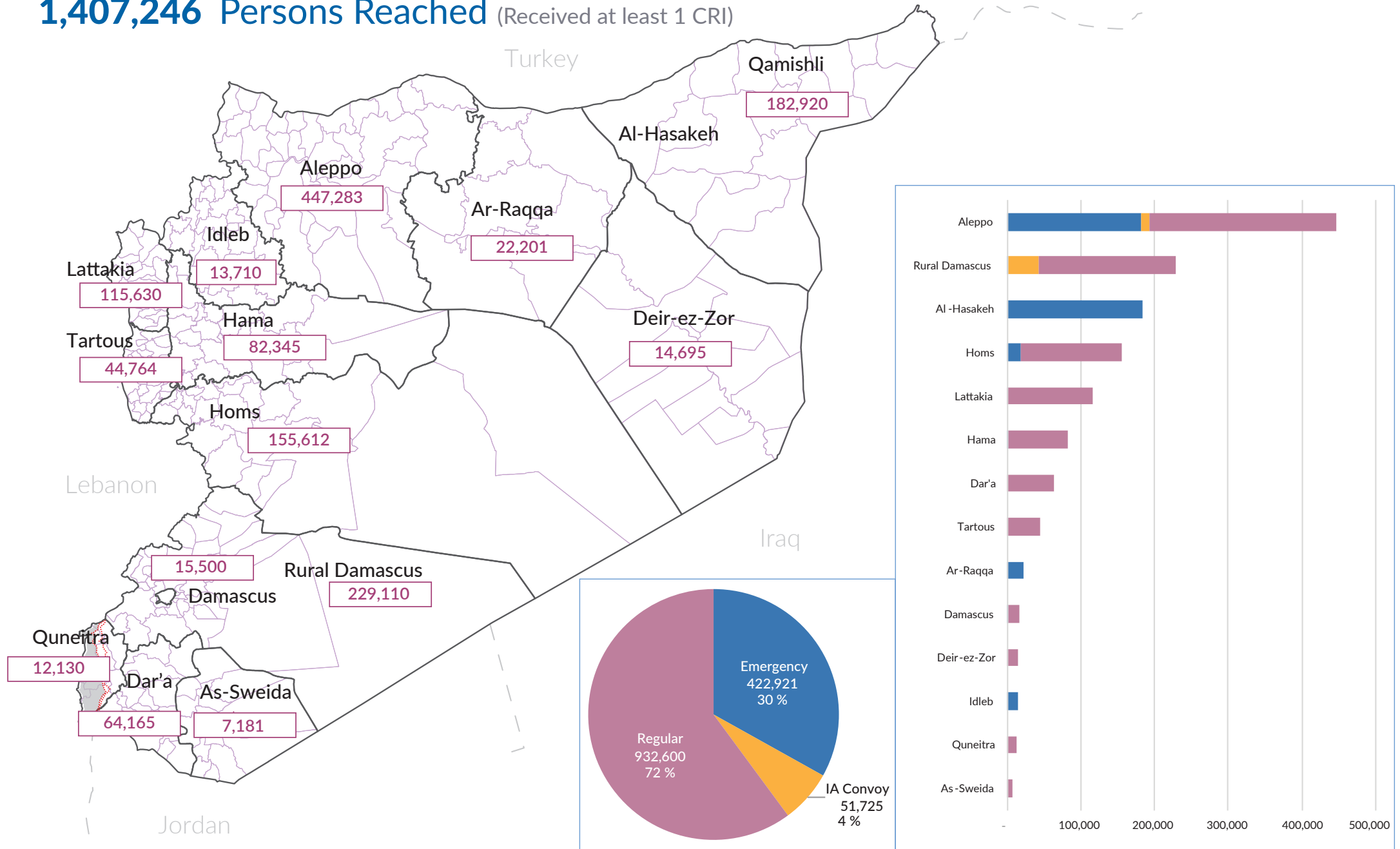

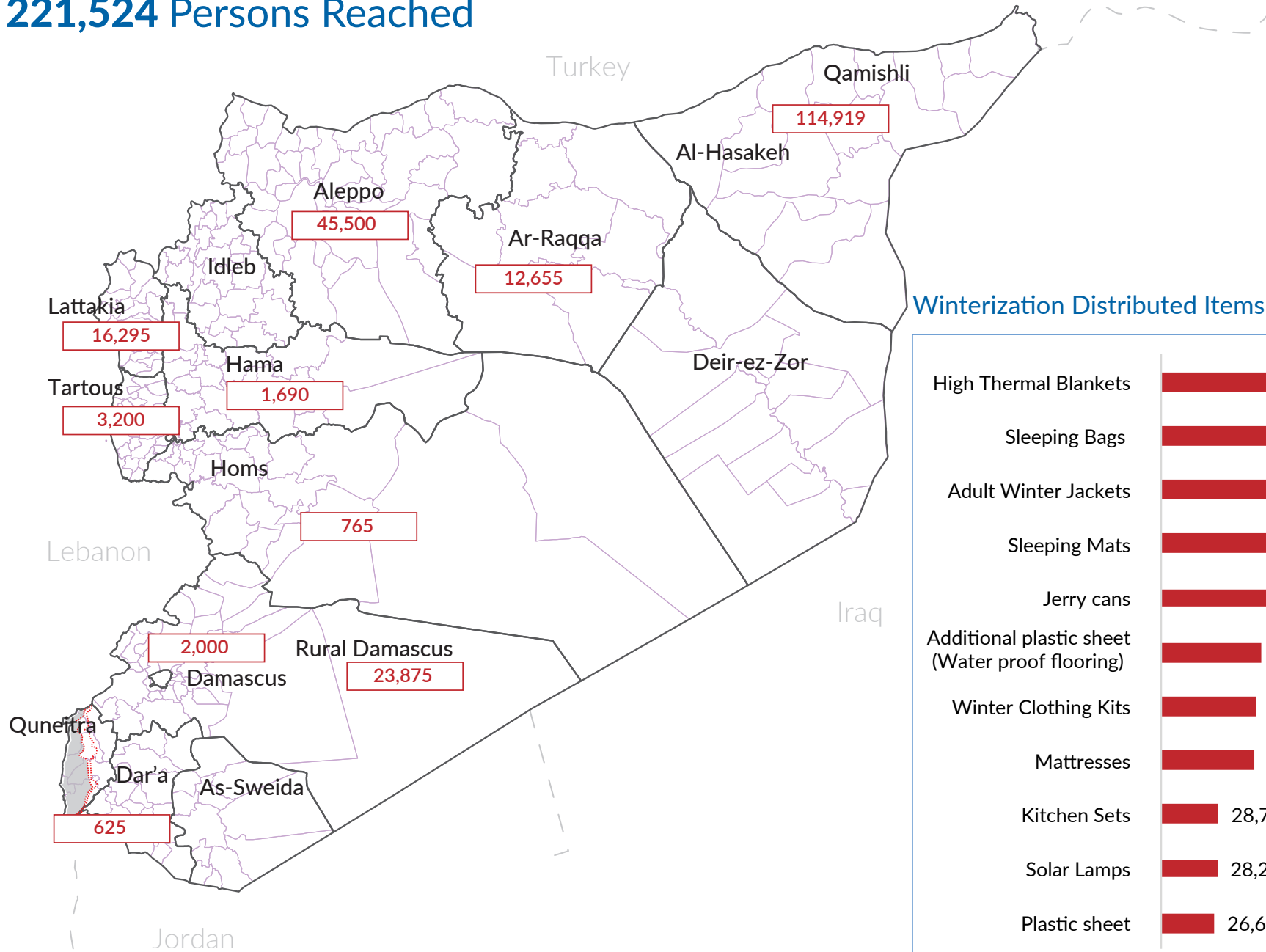
UNHCR SYRIA CORE RELIEF ITEM (CRI) DISTRIBUTION

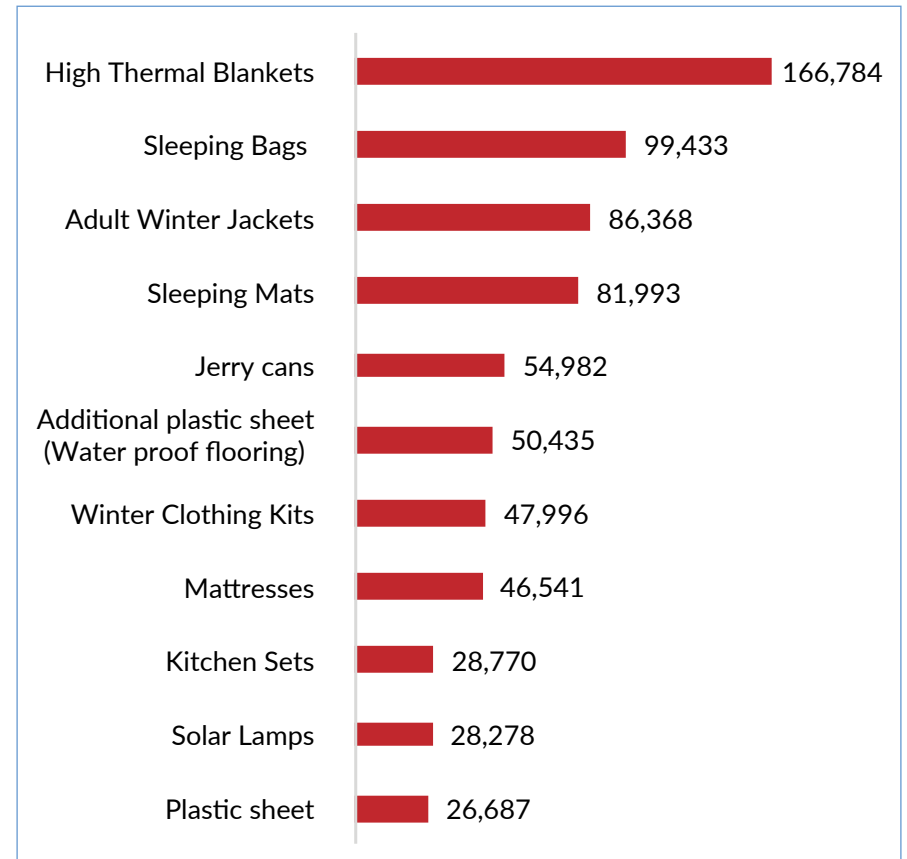


UNHCR SYRIA WINTERIZATION PROGRAMME 2019/2020

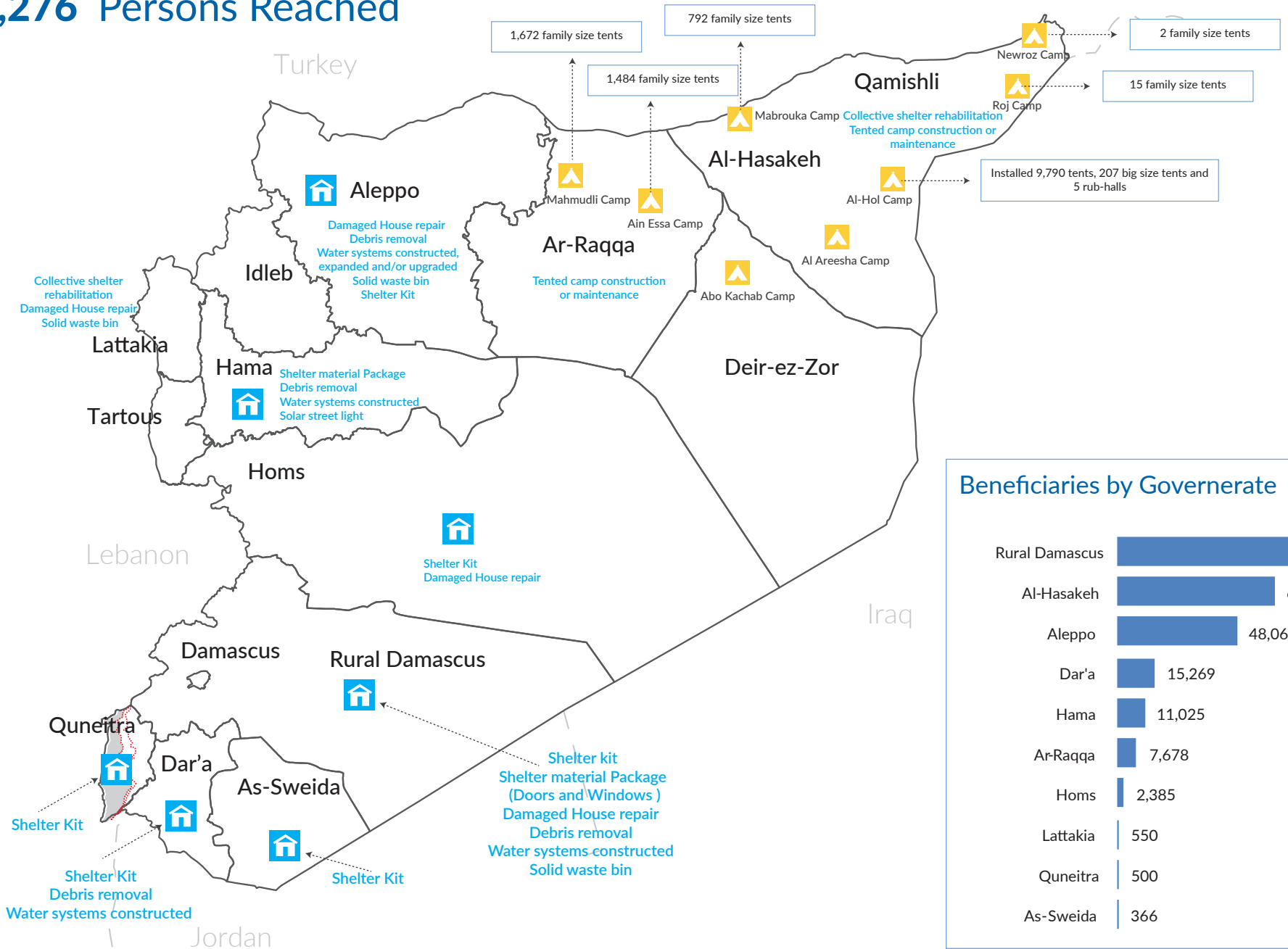

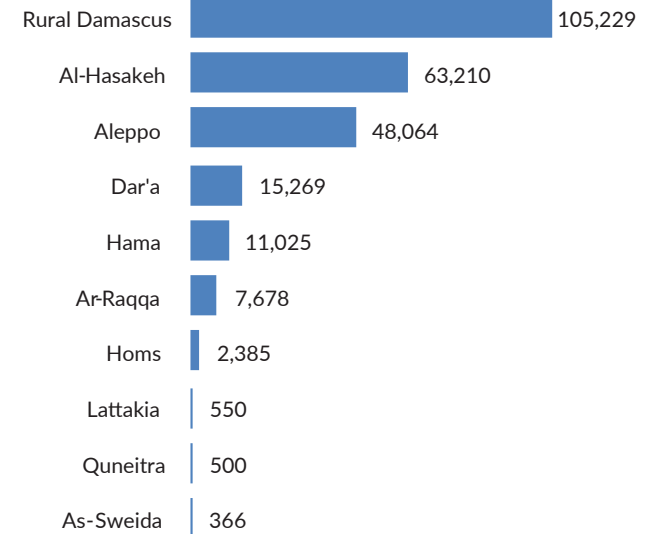


UNHCR SYRIA SHELTER ACTIVITIES

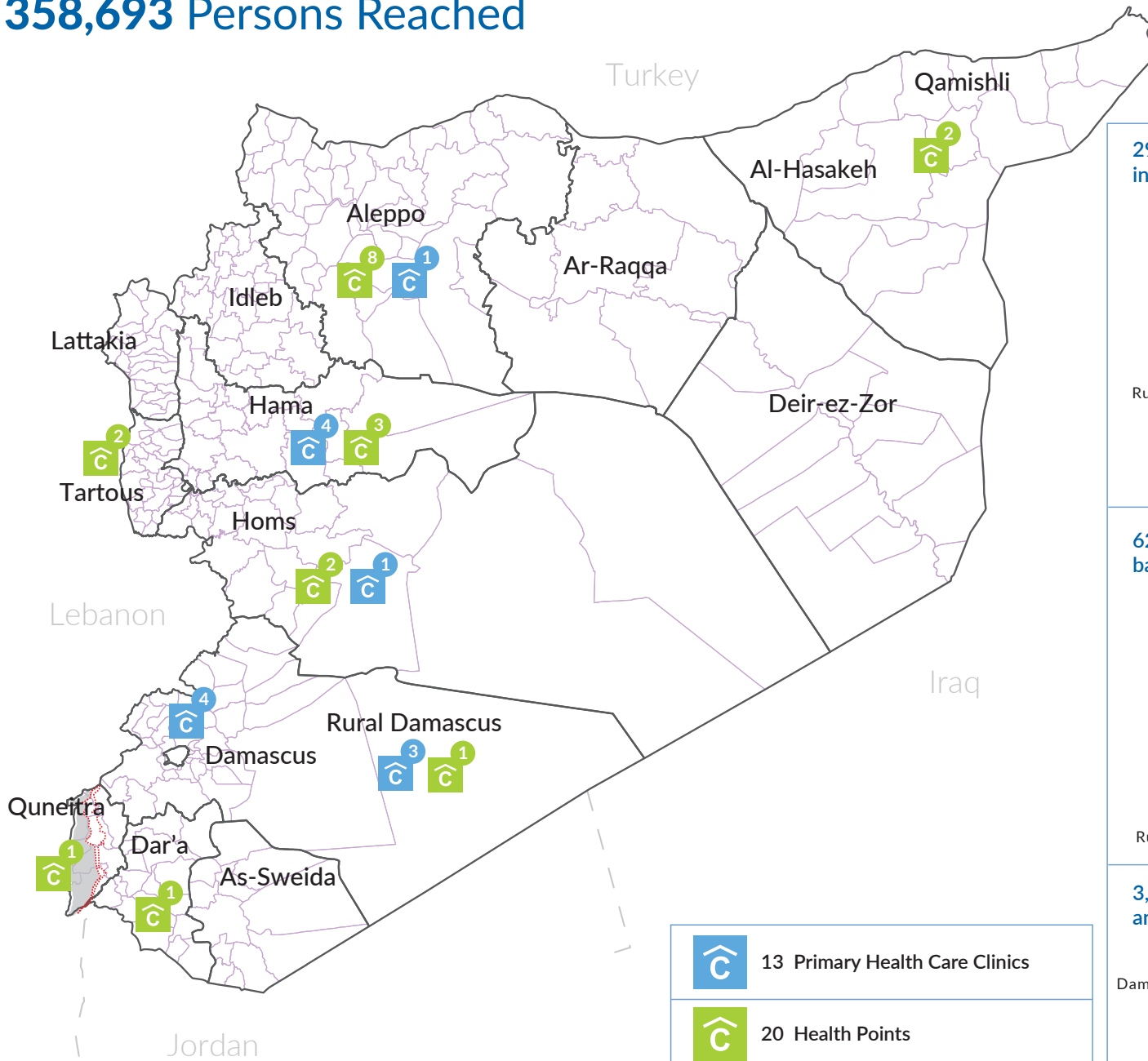


Beneficiaries by Governorate

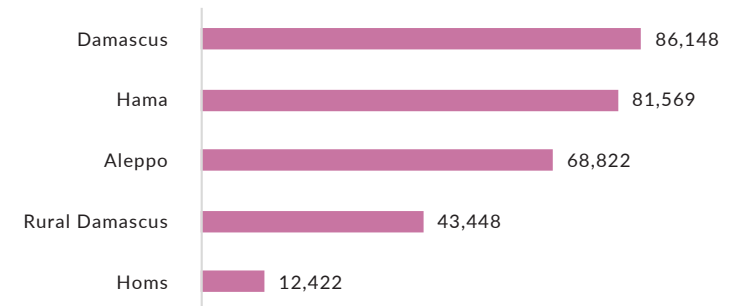

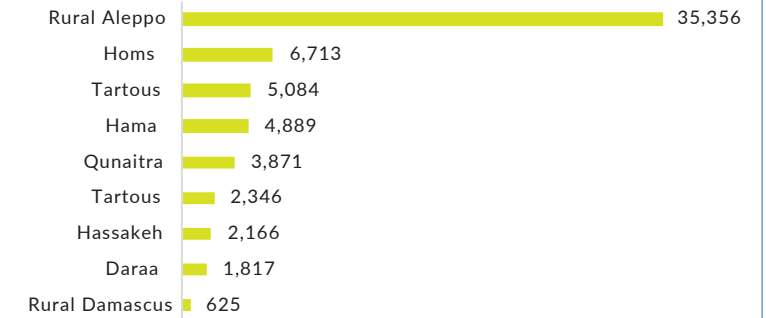

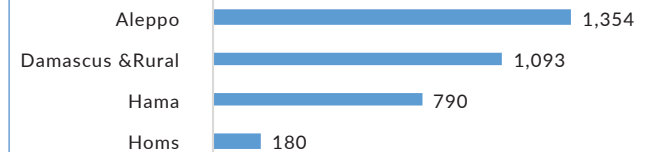

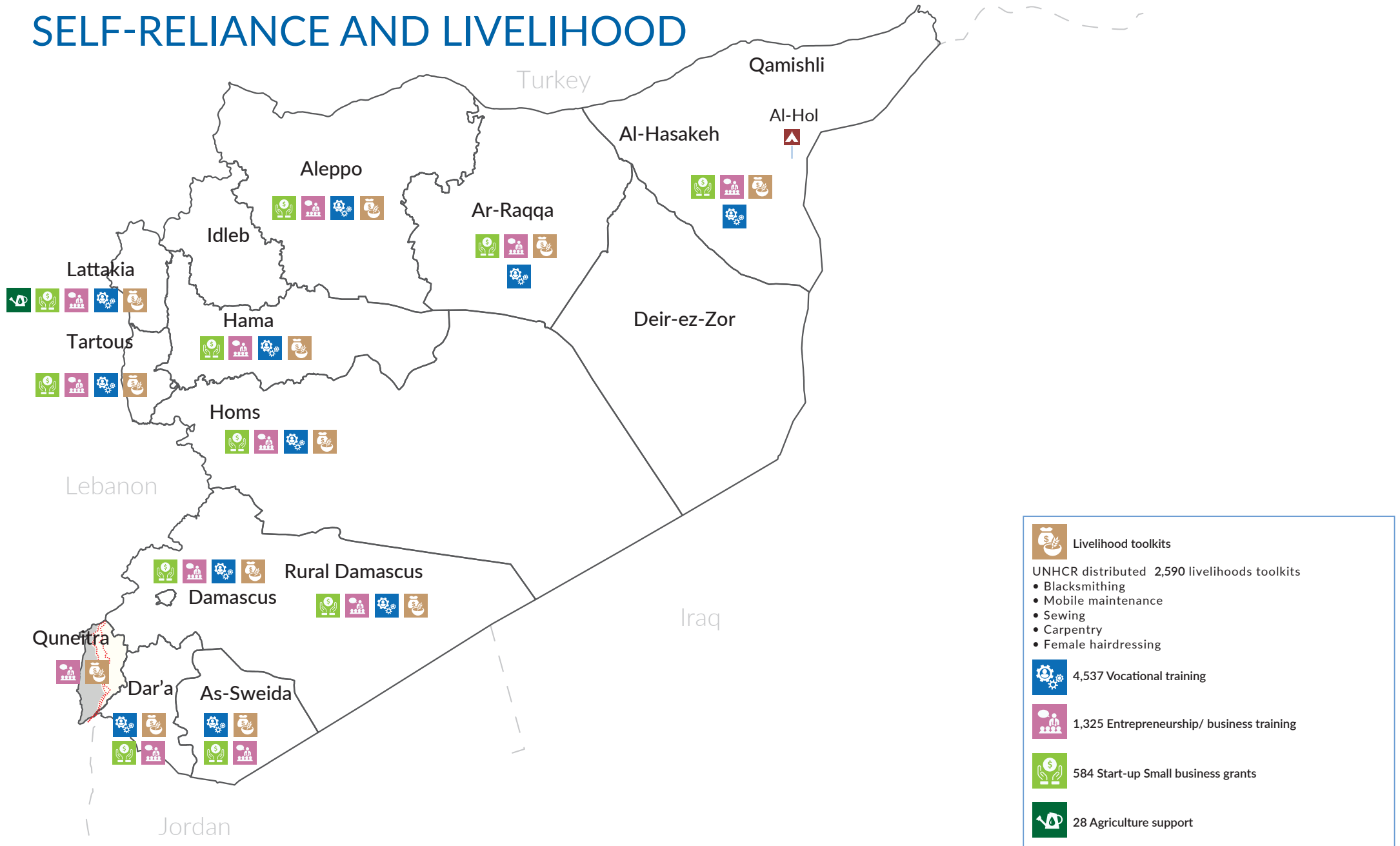

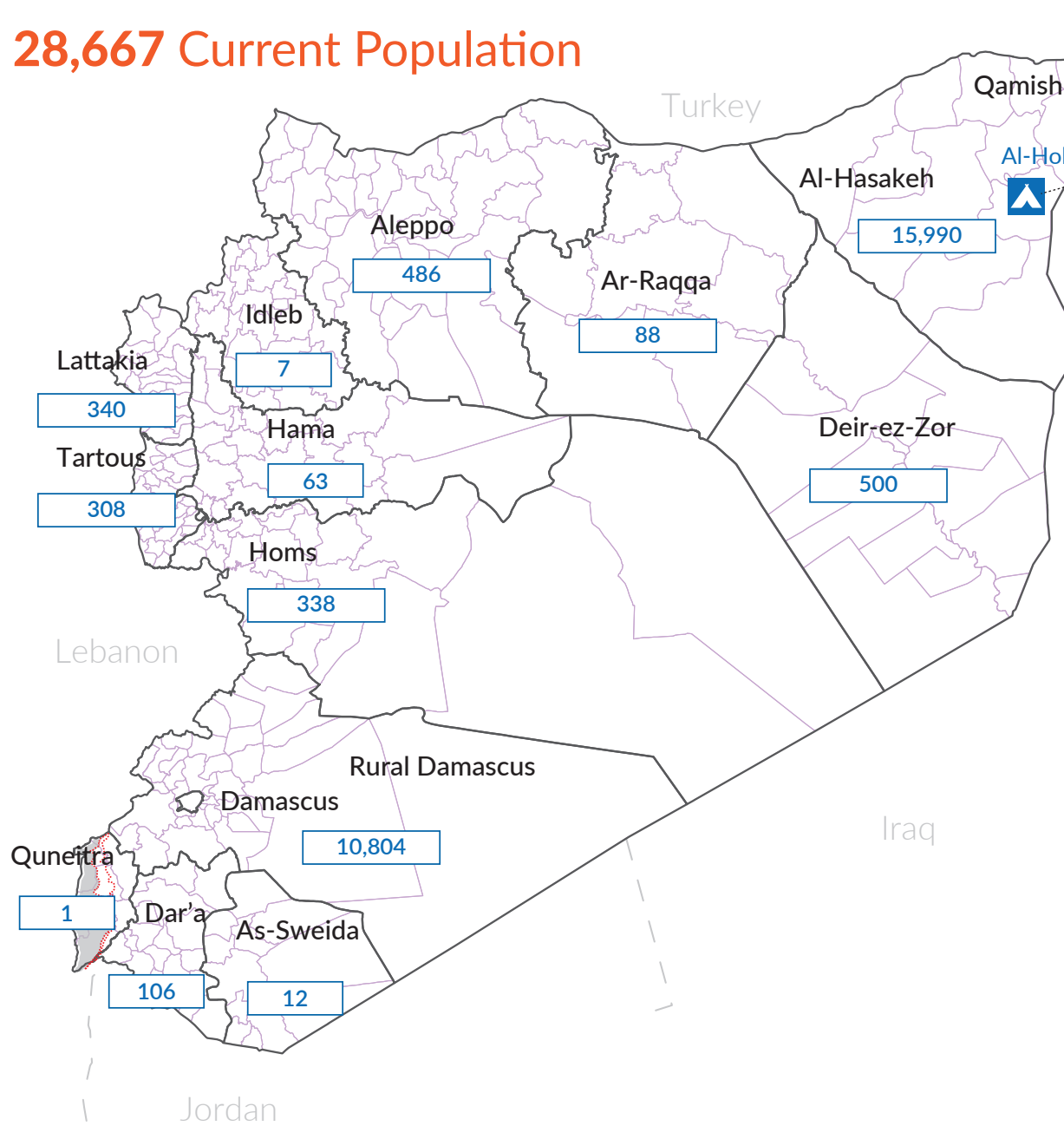

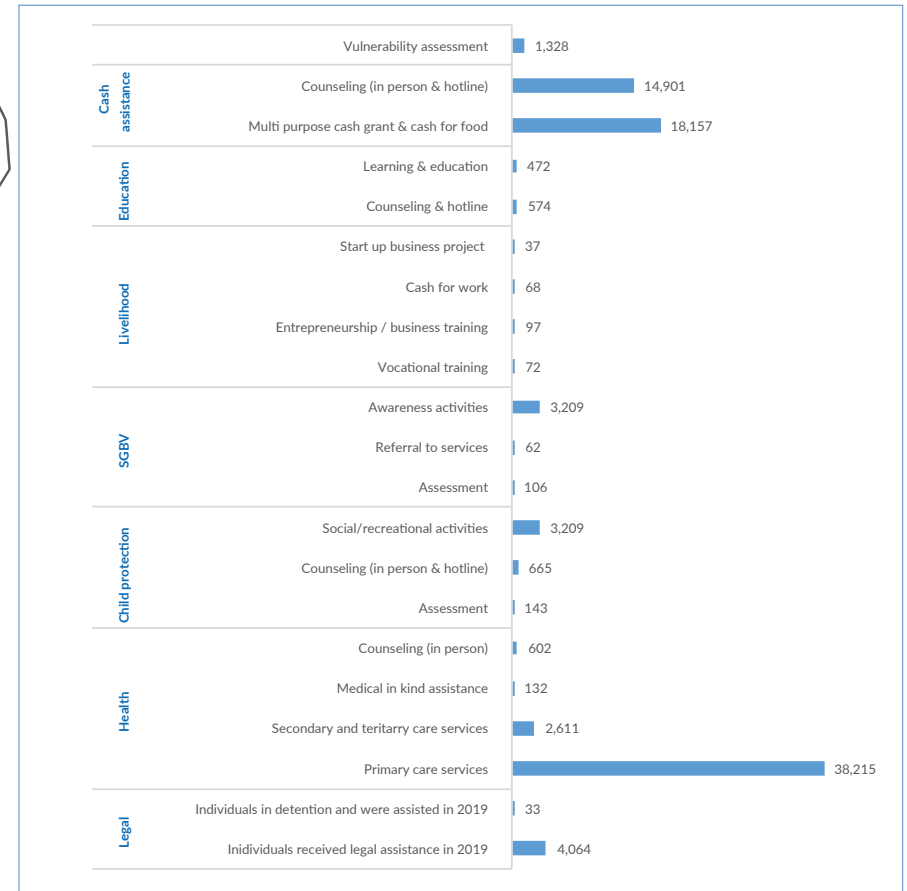

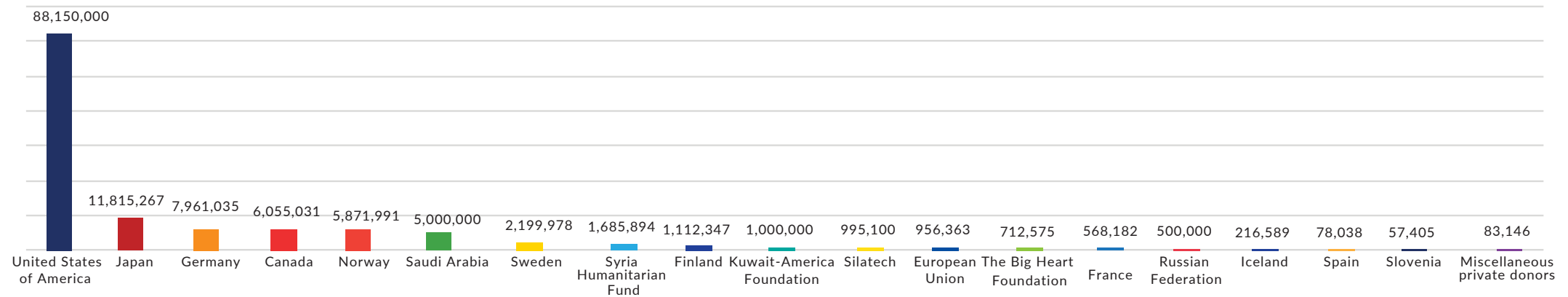
