HUMANITARIAN RESET & UN80


Humanitarian Reset:

- IASC-wide commitment to deliver **faster, fairer, protection-centered, locally-led** humanitarian action under constraints.
- Simplified **planning and coordination** (incl. mixed settings), streamlined **clusters** (Protection, Shelter, Land, and Site Coordination Cluster), and strengthened **country leadership** to reduce duplication.
- Prioritized **localization** and **multipurpose cash**, improving accountability, efficiency, and community-driven outcomes across responses.

UN80

- Humanitarian Compact fast-tracks **shared services, supply chains**, and **data collaboration** to enable Reset delivery.

LOCALIZATION

- **26%** of UNHCR expenditure provided directly to local and national actors (Grand Bargain).
- **59%** of partnership funding went to local and national actors.
- **24%** of UNHCR local or national partners self-identify as RLOs.
- **35%** of Refugee Response Plans partners were local or national actors.
