

**RFP#TURANSUP/RFP/015-2019- Establishment of Frame Agreement for

Bidders' Reply**

**Question 1:** Is it possible for 2 companies presenting a jointly offer? If yes, in this event, must both of the companies be registered in Turkey?

**Answer 1:** You may participate this tender as a joint venture/partnership with another company. Please make sure that both companies has signature and stamp on the joint venture document and submit the Vendor Registration Form and required documents and ensure one of them is registered in Turkey.

In addition, please ensure that the bidding companies are required to be established no less than three (3) years from the closing date of the tender. Bidders who do not comply with this requirement shall be disqualified.

**Question 2:** Is it possible to have the list of the implementing partners?

**Answer 2:** This is a RFP for the establishment of a Frame Agreement. A Frame Agreement is to fix the price for a certain period (for 2 year - extendable for another year) but without a commitment for purchase of service. UNHCR provides estimated number of implementation partners for annual requirements in the tender document only for information proposes. The partnership agreement may not be renewed with same partners next year. The details of the partners will be shared with the winning company.

Awarded companies are expected to fix their price proposal 2 years plus additional 1 year for certain number of partner as indicated on the Annex A document.
