

## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

INVITATION TO BID: No. UKRKI/ITB/2022-02

for the establishment of Frame Agreements for Household Items

<b>No.</b>	<b>Question</b>	<b>Answer</b>
1.	Is it possible to provide blankets with a rectangle or squared lines?	Yes, you can quote for blankets with geometric lines but the item should meet the technical specifications and color requirement as per Annex A.
2.	Do you require a hooded sleeping bag or without a hood?	Please check a sample picture indicated in Annex A, sleeping bags should be without a hood.
3.	What is the required pallet size, is it 120*80 cm? What is the allowed height of the packed pallet?	Please kindly check the packaging instructions in Annex B depending on the item you will be quoting for.
4.	The manufacturer does not produce metal buckets of 20 L without lids. As for the buckets with lids, there are two versions: "hoop lid" and "crown lid". These options are with different closing systems and different purchase prices. The "hoop lid" can be closed by hand. The crown lid is closed and opened with a special key. (Key is not included in the price). Please specify what type of lid for the bucket you need?	As per Annexes A and B of the tender documents, the lids are not part of the requirement. If you provide metal buckets with lids, they should be not heavy to carry when filled in.

5.	In which period UNHCR is planning to procure the quantities mentioned in the tender document?	The figures have been stated in Annex A, Specifications are to enable bidders to indicate the projected requirements. It does not represent a commitment that UNHCR will purchase the quantities on Annex A. Quantities may vary and will depend on the actual requirements and funds available regulated by the issuance of individual Purchase Orders against the Frame Agreement(s). We cannot specify in which period of time we will purchase these items.
6.	Annex B – Sleeping bags, packaging requirements: “The pieces in the primary packing should then be placed in a carton box. The carton boxes shall be palletized and stretch wrapped”. Does it mean each sleeping bag should be packed in a separate carton box?	Please refer to Annexes A and B – packaging requirements. Bidder can suggest in the comments field an acceptable packing unit.
7.	Should we provide the whole blanket as a sample, as we will have to produce as per your specification of min. 500 g/m <sup>2</sup>	Bidders can provide a piece of a blanket with min. 500 g/m <sup>2</sup> as a sample.
8.	Should we strictly follow the packaging rules, f.e. blankets 18 units/bale. Can we pack 10 units/bale?	Yes, packaging requirements should be followed as per the tender documents. If bidders have a better suggestion for packing, please indicate it in the comment field of Annex B.
