- 3.1 Scope and content** The papers relate to the UNHCR operation of the Khao-I-Dang camp in Thailand. They were the UNHCR Representative in Thailand's "Strictly Confidential Khao-I-Dang" file. At the time of donation, Mr. Walzer described the camp as the "last asylum camp for Kampuchean in Thailand. To ensure protection of camp inmates, prevent refoulement to the border and find resettlement solutions was a major challenge for UNHCR in the mid to late 80's and one of the most crucial issues in HCR's dealing with the RTG [Royal Thai Government] and resettlement countries."
- The papers consist of copies of correspondence, reports, and press clippings.
