
#### Oak Tree Shelter Software


The Diocese of Las Cruces, New Mexico developed the Oak Tree program for use by the border shelters in Las Cruces and Deming, New Mexico and allows each shelter to customize its own intake form and user privileges. This specialized platform combines the intake process with travel services into one program. After completion of the intake process, the program automatically contacts the guest's sponsor via a text message to notify them that their loved one has been registered at a migrant shelter and that they will be contacted shortly to arrange travel. The software allows transportation to be coordinated within the platform so that staff can efficiently assist sponsors in purchasing air and bus tickets. There is an optional \$10 service fee to ensure the sustainability of this software program. The Oak Tree software is a comprehensive tool that satisfies the informational needs for intake, travel arrangements, and statistics for reports. 
